
1. On March 8, 2022, Relator filed a petition for writ of mandamus and an emergency motion for temporary relief, both against the district judge of the 353rd District Court of Travis County, Texas. Relator's motion is GRANTED in part. Further proceedings in Cause No. D-1-FM-14-004566, styled *In the Interest of HQH, a Minor Child*, shall continue in the district court, including de novo review of the order signed on February 23, 2022. To preserve this Court's jurisdiction over the pending petition for a writ of mandamus, the February 23rd order is stayed pending further order of this Court.

2. The parties are directed to file a status report with the Court by March 25, 2022.

3. The petition for writ of mandamus remains pending before this Court.

Chief Justice Hecht, Justice Lehrmann, Justice Busby, and Justice Bland dissent from the order granting the stay of the associate judge's order.
